## SIMON SAYS: SNAKES AND LADDERS

This game is a double-aimed-game: children must follow instructions and pay attention on the way their friends give the instructions.

- Give each group of three/four students a game board, a coin and three/four counters.
- Tell them they must all start from the beginning, using the counters to indicate where they are.
- To start, the first student flips the coin: heads is one space forward and tails is two.
- If the students lands on an instruction, the rest of the group shouts the instruction... saying... **Simon says** .... but if the student doesn't says... **Simon say before to tell the instruction** ... the students can't answer and he/she have to go back a space.
- If the student lands on the bottom of a ladder, he/she goes on the top of the ladder and continue from here on the next turn, but if he/she lands on a snake head, the student slides down to the end of the snake.
- The first one to finish wins.
