SIMON SAYS: SNAKES AND LADDERS

This game is a double-aimed-game: children must follow instructions and pay attention on the way their friends give the instructions.

- Give each group of three/four students a game board, a coin and three/four counters.
- Tell them they must all start from the beginning, using the counters to indicate where they are.
- To start, the first student flips the coin: heads is one space forward and tails is two.
- If the students lands on an instruction, the rest of the group shouts the instruction... saying... Simon says but if the student doesn't says... Simon say before to tell the instruction ... the students can't answer and he/she have to go back a space.
- If the student lands on the bottom of a ladder, he/she goes on the top of the ladder and continue from here on the next turn, but if he/she lands on a snake head, the student slides down to the end of the snake.
- The first one to finish wins.
